Our story so far tri-music togethe

The Tri-borough Early Years Music Consortium (TBEYMC) was initiated by the Tri-borough Music Hub in 2015 and consists of 17 partner organisations, all invested in, and committed to supporting and developing EY music practice and provision. The <a href="Iri-Music Together">Iri-Music Together</a> (TMT) project was created by the consortium and with funding from Youth Music, we were able to offer a range of CPD opportunities for EY educators and musicians across the Tri-borough area; Hammersmith and Fulham; Kensington and Chelsea; Westminster. Phase 1 of the project, (2016-18) saw us engage with and support 148 musicians, 249 EY educators, and 120 EY settings. We were able to bring together 2 sectors to learn together, and from each other. Musical Development Matters (MDM) in the EY, a guidance document published in September 2018 forms part of the legacy of the TMT project. Printed copies are available to purchase, or you can download a copy for free <a href="here.">here.</a> MDM has been downloaded 17,000 times and is being well received nationally and internationally – even as far afield as Australia!

## *Currently*

Within the current phase of the TMT project (2019-22) we are continuing to offer CPD opportunities for EY educators and musicians both **within and outside of** the Tri-borough area; continuing to advocate for quality EY music education; looking at and reflecting on each of the TBEYMC partner's EY programmes, and we are strategically supporting Music Education Hubs in England to develop their EY music provision.

- Presented and shared at the 'Tri-borough Innovation in Education Conference'
- Shared Musical Development Matters at the Nursery World Conference in Manchester & London
- Presented and shared at the 'Are you EY Ready' event in Bristol hosted by our friends at Take Art
- Disseminated findings from research into 'Increasing Musical Diversity and Inclusion in Early Childhood Settings' by Nicola Burke and Susan Young
- Delivered a 1-day course on *Musical Development Matters*
- Delivered 2 training sessions for musicians on the Characteristics of Effective Learning
- Delivered day 1 of our 3-day 'Championing music in the EYFS' course
- Begun our support programme for MEH's
- Facilitated a discussion session on Inclusion & Diversity in EY music education



## What is happening next

We are continuing to support Music Education Hubs on their journey in developing their EY music provision through our support programme and the creation of a toolkit (freely available from Spring 2020).
