## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

### Instrument Hire and Charging:

- Instruments can be hired from the TBMH at a charge of **£20 per term** (remissions also apply to this charge).
- Instrument hire costs will be added to the termly invoice.

### Class Information:

- Classes run 10 weeks each term, in term-time.
- Our Music School, Choirs, and Ensembles are delivered and run by fully qualified, DBS checked, and skilled tutors employed by the Tri-borough Music Hub (TBMH).
- There are often end of term concerts and other events which groups perform at.
- Events/performances may be photographed/filmed. If you do not wish your child to be photographed/filmed then please inform the ensemble leader.
- Parents/carers are expected to bring/collect pupils to all rehearsals unless they have given written consent that pupils can leave on their own.
- It is essential that all up to date contact information is provided, in case of an emergency.
- **Pupils wishing to withdraw must do this by giving one term's notice in writing.**

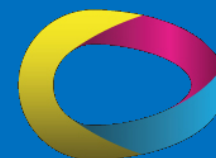
### Accessing Discounts for TBMH Activities (Remissions Policy):

The TBMH heavily subsidises the costs of all our activities to offer value for money to families and to enable equal access. Further discounts also apply.

- **Free School Meals:** Families can access up to a maximum of 50% remissions off the cost of TBMH activity\* if they qualify within any of the following categories:
  - \* Free School Meals
  - \* Ever 6 Free School Meals
  - \* Looked After Children
  - \* Post-Looked After Children: (children who have been adopted from care or left care)
  - \* Service Children: (Ever 6 service child FTE or in receipt of pensions under the Armed Forces Compensation Scheme [AFCS] or the War Pensions Scheme [WPS])\*In all cases proof of entitlement will be required before provision starts
- **Sibling Discount:** Families who do not fall into the above categories can still benefit from a 50% discount for siblings attending the same activity (e.g. both siblings attend the Saturday Music Centre)  
Please note only one subsidised discount can be applied per applicant, up to a maximum of 50% remissions of fees (per pupil).

### Using Your Data:

- All data provided to the TBMH by parents/carers is used for our own timetabling purposes, keeping pupils safeguarded in emergencies, complying with child licensing and child performance legislation and, if required, registering your child as a Young Lyric member. The TBMH will not pass on any pupil or parental data to any third party.
