



## WALK IN THE DINOSAUR FOREST

Musical activity accompanying the Dinosaur song

## A cappella:

keep simple 1-2 rhythm using body percussion – stomp foot (on 1), tap knees (on 2) in medium tempo, once the groove is going start chanting:

1."We're going for a walk in the dinosaur forest, what can we see?"



(point ahead) "Look, there's Diplodocus"

"She goes Stomp Stomp with her feet!" - repeat this line x4, each 'stomp' lasts 4 beats (semibreve), count in your head 1, 2, 3, 4 for each 'stomp', do the stomping action with your feet

2."We're going for a walk in the dinosaur forest, what can we see?"



(point at the sky) "Look, there's Pterodacty!!"

"He goes Flap Flap with his wings!" - repeat this line x4, each 'flap' lasts 2 beats (minim), count in your head 1, 2 for each 'flap', do the flapping action with your bended arms





3."We're going for a walk in the dinosaur forest, what can we see?"



(point to the side) "Look, there's Stegosaurus!"

"She goes Swish Swish Swish Swish with her tail!" - repeat this line x4, each 'swish' lasts 1 beat (crotchet), count in your head 1 for each 'swish', do the swishing action with your forearms

4."We're going for a walk in the dinosaur forest, what can we see?"



(point behind you) "Look, here's T-Rex!"

"He goes Snap Snap Snap Snap Snap Snap Snap with his mouth!" - repeat this line x4, each 'snap' lasts ½ a beat (quaver), count in your head '1 and...' for **two** 'snaps', do the snapping action with palms of your hands

## "Everybody RUN!!!"
